

## M-Step 11 Testing Schedule @ MHS - May 10, 11 or 13 @ 7:45 am

**Testing Sessions Schedule:** Report at **7:45 am to the main entrance** of Madison High School according to **LAST NAME** and current learning option for safety screening

**Requirements** for reporting to school in person to maintain a healthy, safe environment:

1. Correctly wear your face mask
2. Adhere to the safety screening checklist for COVID-19 for admittance
3. Maintain a distance of at least 6 feet at all times from others while in the school building
4. Avoid touching your face and mask, wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds after using the restroom & eating, and use hand sanitizer frequently

Failure to adhere to these requirements will result in dismissal and the test will be voided. If a student does not feel well on test day, please ensure they stay home.



### Day of the Test:

- M-Step is composed of 2 tests - Science and Social Studies - both of which do not have a time limit, so students will work and finish at their own pace
- Backpacks, purses, phones and smart watches are NOT permitted in testing rooms – please leave them at home or in your car, or be prepared to store them in your locker or in the office
- Bottled water and nut-free snacks are permitted for you to bring to have during the 10 minute break between your Science and Social Studies tests
- Assigned room and seats – proctors will guide you to safely-distanced assigned seats
- Restrooms – one student at a time will be permitted to leave the classroom to use the restroom

### Wear your Mask Correctly

- Wash your hands before putting on your mask
- Put it over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin
- Try to fit it snugly against the sides of your face
- Make sure you can breathe easily



Be prepared for the Safety Screening Checklist for COVID-19 prior to entering the school building:

- Temperature (if >100.4 no admittance)
- Answer the following safety questions:
  - o Signs & Symptoms: fever, chills, dry cough, difficulty breathing, diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain
  - o Travel during the past 14 days
  - o Close contact with a confirmed/probable COVID-19 case

Entry will be denied to any student who answers yes to safety questions, or refuses to answer them.
