We are planning for the option of in-person learning to begin February 8, 2021. We will begin the first week back with a staggered start. Each grade level will come in on their own day to make the transition as smooth as possible.

Learning Plan - Benefits

The guiding principle for the Return to Learn Learning Plan is to create teaching and learning conditions that maximize instructional integrity while following all recommended precautions to minimize risk and create meaningful student engagement. Building administration recommends this plan because of these benefits:

- Providing both in-person and virtual instruction options to families
- Value of daily in-person guided instruction and support
- Focuses on health and safety for our students and staff
- Consistent weekly schedule for students district wide

In-Person Learning

Classroom

- Students will continue using the same virtual platforms during in-class instruction to complete assignments.
- All students will have assigned seats safely distanced in each classroom, all facing in the same direction
- All students will be required to use their own set of supplies and deployed devices
- Tutoring will be offered on Tuesday/Thursday after school

Hallways/Lunch

- Students will only be using every other locker in order to stay socially distanced from others at their lockers
- Students will only be allowed to visit their locker when they arrive at school and at dismissal
- All students will have socially distanced assigned seats in the cafeteria with a pre-wrapped lunch provided

Virtual Learning

Instruction

- Google Meet will continue to be used for live instruction
- Virtual and in-person instruction will be simultaneous
- All students will continue doing work posted on Google Classrooms

Schedule

- Virtual live GM class schedule will change to match in-person school schedule.
- Tutoring after school will be on Tuesday and Thursday only, unless specifically scheduled with teacher

Wednesday - All students will participate in Asynchronous Virtual Instruction

Students arriving: 7:30 AM (students will use designated entrances)

School day begins: 7:45 AM

School day ends: 2:31 PM

Breakfast will be served in classrooms

Lunch will be served in the cafeteria with students facing same direction in assigned seating and socially distanced

MHS Health & Safety Protocols

- Face masks must be worn (over mouth & nose) by all students to enter the building, and throughout the school day. The only time the face mask may be removed by a student is while eating.
- Students shall exercise social distancing when in the hallways and when using the bathrooms
- Handwashing must be done after using the bathroom
- Students shall use hand sanitizer each time they enter a classroom
- Students must follow the directional decals in hallways to keep flow of traffic one way
- Social distancing decals are placed on the floor and walls to assist in promoting social distancing while in lunch line

Protocols to Stay Safe

Temperature Checks



All students and staff will have temperatures checked upon entrance to the building each day. Parents must screen students prior to sending them to school each day.



Mask Wearing

All students and staff must wear a mask to enter the building and all day, unless eating/drinking while sitting.

Mitigation Room

A student displaying symptoms during the school day will be sent to the mitigation room. That student and any siblings must be picked up within the hour.



Ensuring Safety

To ensure the health and safety of our staff and students, and in accordance with the safety protocols in place by MHS and the OCHD, MHS administration will proceed with the following consequences upon non-compliance:

- *1st offense - The student will be sent home for the day*
- *2nd offense - The student will be moved back to virtual learning.*

Safety Protocols & Compliance

- **Parents MUST screen their child at home each morning following the Oakland County Health Department screening protocol:**

Fever (100.4 degrees or greater)

Sore throat

Cough

Diarrhea (2x in 24 hours)

**Shortness of breath/difficulty
breathing**

Nausea or vomiting (2x in 24 hours)

Congestion or runny nose

Chills

Headache

Muscle or body aches

Fatigue

New loss of taste/smell

**** Parents must not send students to school if sick, experiencing any of the above symptoms, or if someone else at home has a confirmed case of Covid-19**

Safety Protocols & Compliance (Cont.)

When can you return to school?

- Per the Oakland County Health Dept. a student may return to school after 10 days have passed and they have no fever for 24 hours without taking fever reducing medications and symptoms have improved.

Safety Protocols & Compliance

- **Parents MUST NOT use medication to reduce a known fever and send their child to school.**
- **A student displaying fever or any symptom must:**
 - **Be excluded from school for 10 days,**
OR
 - **Provide documentation of a negative test for Covid-19 by PCR test (Rapid test not acceptable)**
- **Students MUST be picked up from school when a parent is contacted due to the student displaying symptoms of Covid-19 (any siblings of the student must be picked-up as well)**
- **Parents MUST have sufficient (multiple) emergency contacts on file to be able to pick-up a student from school in the event that a parent is unavailable.**

Students and families who do not abide by these requirements shall be transferred to virtual learning for the health and safety of the school community.

Covid-19 Health & Safety Screening Agreement

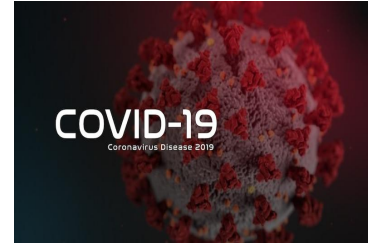
If you are choosing to send your student(s) to in-person learning you will need to submit the Covid-19 Health & Safety Screening Agreement.
